Choir Club is a two-fold track for the fall, starting August 30:

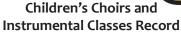
- Singing on-line only will be available Sundays at noon, with in-person recording sessions by smaller groups on the below dates.

Choir Time (Vocal) for each age groups will be available on our YOUTUBE channel each Sunday afternoon at noon beginning August 30. The lessons will stay on-line for 4 weeks, so that each child has a chance to learn and review the singing portion of Choir. Each registered child will receive a copy of the age appropriate MUSIC MENU. The MUSIC MENU will contain copies of the music we are learning, copies of the hymns we are emphasizing, plus supplemental learning materials.

All groups will participate in the YOUTUBE/ONLINE basic music and singing curriculum, learn songs that will be recorded for the on-line worship services, and have the opportunity to participate with in-home instruments. The MUSIC MENU lesson notebook for all age groups will be available in the Church Office and the Music Office beginning August 31, and will include a list of recording dates and times for the children to record on Wednesday afternoons to record for worship services and seasonal services later in the semester.



Additional On-Site Instruction for K-4th Grade
